Introduction

The Citizens Charter is a National Priority Program (NPP) of the National Unity Government (NUG) that was officially launched on September 25, 2016.

The Citizens Charter is an inter-ministerial, multi-Sectorial NPP, where Ministries have collaborated to provide basic services to rural communities. The key service delivery ministries involved are: Ministry of Rural Rehabilitation and Development (MRRD), Ministry of Education (MoE), Ministry of Public Health (MoPH) and Ministry of Agriculture, Irrigation and Livestock (MAIL), with oversight by Ministry of Finance (MoF). MRRD has a key role and will be responsible for infrastructural development and strengthening CDCs and Cluster CDCs. The Community Development Councils (CDCs) will be linked to sub-national government to improve communication and coordination from the community to the district, provincial and national levels - increasing Government visibility and accountability. The Citizens' Charter is an important foundation for the Government's reform agenda, contributing to a number of priority areas including: Ensuring Citizens' Development Rights; Building Better Governance; Reforming Development Planning & Management and Developing Partnerships.

The Citizens Charter intends to improve service delivery by ensuring minimum service standards, provide greater responsiveness by the Government to the people and increase the level of public satisfaction with services. The Charter commits to deliver the following core services across the country over a 10 year period:

- ➤ Basic health services
- ➤ Basic education access
- > Safe drinking water and sanitation
- > Improved farming technologies and the delivery of extension services
- Rural connectivity with tertiary roads
- Rural renewable energy

Program Background:

• The government of Afghanistan plans to implement the Citizen's Charter Afghanistan Project (CCAP) to improve service delivery to communities the country. CCAP will set threshold of core services to be provided to all communities. Community Development Councils will be become the mechanism for the line agencies to plan manage local-level service delivery.

The CCAP Objectives are:

- Break cycle of fragility and violence, by deepening the legitimacy of Afghan state.
- Reduce poverty by providing universal access to core set of basic services.

Engineering Department (Eng. Dept):

The Engineering Department (Eng. Dept) provides technical engineering support to large and small-scale infrastructure projects implemented by CCAP with the support of its regional, provincial and district engineers. Eng. Dept currently comprises four units: Road & Bridge Unit, Water Supply and Sanitation (WAS) Unit, Irrigation Unit and Renewable & Alternative Energy Unit (RAEU).

Road and Bridge Unit:

The Road and Bridge Unit is part of the Engineering Division of CCAP under the supervision of Head of Engineering Division; support and supervise the various tasks of Road and Bridge sector, also support and guide the activities of sector at CCAP engineering technical staff at the field level. The MCCG Engineer will be part of Transport (Road and Bridge) Unit, under direct supervision of Road and Bridge Unit Head.

Core Duties and Responsibilities:

Contribute effectively to the improvement or modification of the existing Technical Manual (TM) especially technical part related to MCCG's subprojects.

Records and prepares technical reports and correspondence related to the work with scope of problem and recommendations.

Providing and upgrading of subproject checklists and guidelines.

Effective coordination with regional, provincial and district engineers relevant to MCCG's subprojects

Providing of road and bridge maintenance guidelines including picture book at community level by local languages

Verification of subproject proposals technical from # 8 through MIS system.

Liaising with others MRRD directorates and departments when required during, project survey, design and implementation.

Coordination large scale road and bridge subprojects with MRRD other relevant Department for subproject design completion and, then submission to field colleagues while required.

Providing of training material regarding of road and bridge survey, design, quality and implementation.

Providing of technical specifications for MCCG's subprojects quality and sustainability

Giving of reports to road and bridge unit head regarding technical activities, conduction of technical missions, technical trainings and etc.

Design of roads and bridges if needed

Meeting with sectors line ministries and agencies on relevant sectors.

Carries out technical review of complex subproject proposals to ensure that project is technically feasible and design is optimum.

Identify, contribute to the development of engineering training material and participate to practical training activity.

Conducing technical support mission to filed

Random check of approved complex subproject proposals at the provincial and regional level

Receive and investigates emergency calls from regional, provincial and district technical colleagues and response technical assistance to them.

Keep communication with the regions and provincial engineers to identify their engineering needs, and will organize deployment of support engineers to these areas.

Provide technical assistance to regional, provincial and district engineers when required during the; project survey, design, implementation and monitoring

Capacity development of regional, Provincial and district road and bridge sector staff through various means.

Establishing and providing guidelines and procedures for conducting of technical survey for road, water supply, irrigation and MHP

Bringing comprehensive positive changes in community level roads and pathways design

Providing maintenance guidelines for road and bridge, irrigation and water supply completed subprojects.

Any other responsibility assigned by the Road and Bridge Unit Head or Head of Engineering Division.
