The event was inaugurated by the Mirajuddin Shams, Deputy Minister for Admin and Finance of the Ministry. He gave useful speech on the implementation of constitution and obligations of the government in the rural development sector.



He added "Constitution is the mother of all laws and other laws are taken from it. Fortunately, the Afghan constitution is one of the best laws in the region, because it is written in the context of Islamic law and people's traditions."

Mr. Shams talked about article 6 of this law, which outlines the duties of the Ministry of Rural Rehabilitation and Development. He emphasized Ministry's cooperation with the Independent Commission for Oversight of on the Implementation of the Constitution in implementation of the constitution by holding programs and workshops.

Mohammed Farooq Fakir, Head of Department for Monitoring the Implementation of the Constitution in ministries and governmental offices talked about the history of constitution, its and its executive guarantees.



Mr. Aminullah Shariq, the ministry's adviser, said having law can made up a society in order. He added "The Afghan constitution provides the most rights to the citizens, and the obligation of nationals to comply with it is even greater. Citizens have a greater obligation in the implementation of the constitution."

Mr. Ghulam Rabbani Adib, legal adviser to the ministry, said: "The constitution in the world of humanity is the Quran and Afghanistan's constitution is derived from it."

The event was attended by more than 100 ministry staff.

Practical implementation of the VSLA survey related to the WEERDP program

The assessment and evaluation survey of the financial and operational sustainability of the village savings groups (VSLA) related to the WEERDP Program was completed in five provinces by the survey and research unit of AIRD.

The survey was conducted in 5 provinces (Nangarhar, Herat, Parwan, Bamyan and Balkh), in 27 districts and in 225 CDCs. After collecting the data from planned communities, uploading the data to the database and analyzing and the data, final survey report has been submitted WEERDP.

Based on the proposal of this program and Decree of H.E Minister of Rural, Rehabilitation and Development, AIRD was assigned to conduct the assessment and evaluation survey of the financial and operational sustainability of the village savings groups (VSLA) related to the WEERDP.
